Lavaliering Ceremony

This ceremony is intended to be used when a brother presents the fraternity letters to someone they are dating in a serious relationship.

Brothers, each holding a lit candle, form an aisle from the "A" to the individual to be Lavaliered.

"A" - Would _____ please step forward?

(Brothers hum the Bond Song as the individual walks down the aisle and continue humming until the Lavalier is presented)

The Lavalier has been a longstanding tradition and honor within the Delta Chi Fraternity. When a Brother reaches a certain level of emotion in a relationship and wishes to express feelings not expressible through words or any other action, the only means of expressing these feelings is through the ideals upon which The Delta Chi Fraternity was founded — the ideals Brother _____ and every other man of Delta Chi hold nearest to their hearts. As you wear the letters Delta and Chi on your chest, let them be symbols representative not only of the love and devotion a Brother has towards the ideals of Delta Chi, but also of the love and devotion Brother _____ has for you. You will now be presented with the Lavalier of The Delta Chi Fraternity and welcomed by the Brotherhood.
