

## DALE CARNEGIE SCHOLAR KNOW BEFORE YOU GO



### HISTORY OF THE RLA PROGRAM:

For years, Delta Chi hosted a president training event known as “A’s” Academy, and the nine governing Regions hosted annual leadership conferences for our active and alumni members, known as Regional Leadership Conferences (RLCs). During the 2023 RLCs, each of Delta Chi’s nine regional bodies voted in favor of the Board of Regents redirecting the 2024 RLC program to a Regional Leadership Academy format. In 2024, Delta Chi’s nine regions voted to continue the Regional Leadership Academy (RLA) program for 2025. At the 2024 International Convention, a vote was also taken to reduce the regions from nine to six, with elections to take place during RLA 2025.

This Regional Leadership Academy format will allow Delta Chi members to engage in a weekend of officer development, leadership training, and action planning. Sessions will be held over two weekends, and chapters/provisional chapter members and alumni will attend their designated RLA (see above) and participate in a brotherhood experience like no other!

### WHAT WILL HAPPEN AT THE 2025 REGIONAL LEADERSHIP ACADEMY?

For our Dale Carnegie Scholars, Delta Chi’s four Regional Leadership Academies (RLAs) will be where scholars complete their Dale Carnegie certification training, present their “Final Talks,” and select their Highest Achievement Award winners. Scholars will be able to engage in most general sessions, including ritual exemplification, but their weekend schedule (see final page) will focus on enhancing their professional skills.

### WHO ATTENDS RLA?

For the 2025 Regional Leadership Academy experience, participants will include:

- Small group (known as “POD”) Facilitators

Undergraduate chapters/provisional chapters are expected to send a minimum of four representatives to their respective RLA, which must include their “A” and Dale Carnegie Scholar.

## WHEN AND WHERE IS RLA?

RLA will be held over two different weekends in January 2025. Each weekend, events will begin on Friday with dinner and end mid-morning on Sunday before lunch.

Scholars will also participate in two virtual pre-program sessions. See final page for details.

## WHAT IS THE DRESS CODE?

RLA attire expectations are as follows:

- **Friday:** Delta Chi casual (lettered shirts/sweatshirt or appropriate fraternity event shirts/sweatshirts, jeans/khakis, clean sneakers/shoes)
- **Saturday day:** Professional casual (polos/sweaters / button-up shirts, khakis or suit pants with boat shoes/loafers)
- **Saturday evening:** Business professional (Suit jacket and pants, Button-up shirt, Tie, Dress Shoes, Delta Chi badge)
- **Sunday:** Delta Chi casual (RLA Shirt received at check-in, jeans/khakis, clean sneakers/shoes)

## WHAT DOES RLA COST? WHAT DOES THAT INCLUDE?

All chapters/provisional chapters will be charged the **\$1200 RLA Assessment fee** approved by the Board of Regents. This will cover the registration (including program materials, RLA shirts, etc.), meals (Friday dinner through Sunday breakfast), and hotel costs (two nights) for up to eight (8) representatives. Chapters/provisional chapters may send additional representatives for a fee of \$150 per person (which covers the same items).

RLA participants will share hotel rooms with their chapter/provisional chapter brothers. Rooms will accommodate four members per room. For those chapters/provisional chapters registering more than eight members, those individuals will be placed in a hotel room with other Delta Chi members (typically Dale Carnegie Scholars will be roommates as their schedule differs slightly from the rest of the attendees), and to the best of our ability, placed in rooms near or with their chapter/provisional chapter members.

All representatives must register themselves to attend RLA by December 15, 2024, and Scholars will need to select the Dale Carnegie track on their submission.

## WHAT ABOUT TRAVEL SUPPORT?

All participants are expected to secure their own travel to attend RLA, and typically members will travel together to the program. However, chapters / provisional chapters are eligible for travel credits after the program if they meet the following criteria:

1. "A" attends and participates in the "A's" Academy track, in accordance with Delta Chi Law (or is excused by their Regent due to extenuating circumstances).
2. Chapter/provisional chapter sends at least four (4) members to comply with minimum attendance requirements.
3. At least four (4) members attend all general sessions and their respective breakout sessions and are marked for attendance.

If all conditions are met, the chapter/provisional chapter will receive a travel credit on their account. The amount is based on the chapter / provisional chapter's campus distance from the host location, and is not designed to and will not cover all costs associated with travel. There may be some additional funding available for chapters that have extenuating circumstances.
